




### Where Does the Money Come From?

#### Sales Tax- 33%

The County receives sales tax of 3.75% on all taxable goods and services in Dutchess County. The county currently keeps 82% and shares 18% with municipalities.

#### State & Federal Aid- 23%

The State and Federal Government provide funding to help pay for some programs and services the county provides.



#### Property Tax- 25%

Property owners pay taxes based on their property's assessed value and the tax rate is determined by the Adopted County Budget.

#### Other Revenue- 19%

This category includes all other revenue sources such as fees for services, revenue from a 4% Hotel/ Motel Tax, Off-Track Betting revenue, and can include the use of savings.




